Calvary Chapel of Gloucester County is excited to announce that we have again been chosen to host the Tim Tebow Foundation's Night To Shine Prom. As you may know, this prom is specific to special need individuals ages 14 and older (our oldest guest last year was 64). It is held on the same night throughout the world in more than 500 churches.


We transform our sanctuary into a grand ballroom with decorations, paparazzi, red carpet, a quiet room, sensory room, karaoke room, and of course the main room for dining and dancing. Due to the overwhelming response last year, we expanded our seating to accommodate 150 guests and their buddies. Each guest is paired with a buddy who has expertise in their field (sign language specialists, nurses, special education teachers and assistants, etc., all of whom volunteer their time).

Although we do receive a small financial grant from the Tim Tebow Foundation, we still have to fundraise approximately \$ 16,000 this year for rentals of tables, chairs, linens, dinnerware, dance floor, stanchions, red carpet, photo booth, backpacks, and of course, the dinner. Our guests receive **complimentary** hair and makeup done by professional makeup artists and stylists, a tuxedo or gown (as well as alterations), limo rides, corsages, boutonnieres, a framed photo, and a backpack filled with small gifts. The night ends with each guest crowned King and Queen after a live streamed message from Tim Tebow. Here is a breakdown of our most expensive costs:

Food	5000.00
Tables, chairs, linens, stanchions, red carpet, lighting, etc.	5500.00
Backpacks with gifts	3000.00
Tiaras and Crowns	800.00
Dance Floor	1000.00
Balloons and decorations	1000.00
